Installation

After removing the packaging, make sure the equipment is intact.

Remove the protection films from the steel sheet, if any.

Instructions for user

Do not move the trolley on uneven floors to avoid damage.

Do not stop and leave the equipment on a slope.

If the equipment is fitted with braked castors, engage them when you reach the desired position.

Maintenance and cleaning

CLEANING: Use a soft cloth and a neutral detergent. Never use products like chlorine, bleach, etc., that may

corrode or damage stainless steel.

Do not clean the surfaces using a steel scouring pad, a brush or a steel scraper

MAINTENANCE Before using the trolley, ensure that castors are not blocked by dust or dirt particles. If necessary,

clean the castors thoroughly
